Physician Assistant: There appears to be no provisions permitting licensure based on reciprocity.

Temporary License: The Board may grant a temporary license to an applicant who meets the qualifications for licensure except that the applicant has not yet taken the national certifying examination administered by the NCCPA or the applicant has taken the national certifying examination and is awaiting the results or the applicant has not obtained a minimum of a master's degree in a health-related or science field.

This temporary license is valid:

A. for one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of issuance;

B. until the results of an applicant's examination are available; or

C. until the Board makes a final decision on the applicant's request for licensure, whichever comes first.
